

# Introduction to Great Lent

(Compiled by Rev, Prathish George M.)

## Fasts and Feasts

Fasts and Feasts can be helpful to us if we take time to understand the meaning and purpose of each. It will encourage us to be with Christ throughout the year and experience salvation through the meditation of the Word of God, Confession, Prayer and Worship. The Mar Thoma Church follows a lectionary which is arranged throughout the year (chronological Order). The liturgical year is as follows.

### The Sanctification of the Church (Kudos Etho)

The renewal of the Church (hudos etho) – 25 days lent – mar Thoma Sabha Dinam – Baptism of Jesus Christ (Danaha/Epiphany) – Annunciation (Suboro)- Fast of Nineveh – The Great Lent- Acension of Lord Jesus – Fast of the Apostles (Sleeha Nombu) – Feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord- Feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary. From 'We Believe'

### Great Lent (Saumo Rabo)

The Great Lent commences (usually) in the month of February which is calculated as per Lunar Calendar. It is 50 days fast- 40 days in which our Lord fasted and 10 days to remember the passion of Christ. The first Monday of this Lent is observed as the service of reconciliation (Shubkono). 40 th day of the Lent is observed as 40 th Friday. This symbolizes the forty days of fasting of Jesus in the wilderness. On Palm Sunday (Hosanna) we remember Jesus' great entry into Jerusalem on a donkey. Passover Thursday (pesaha) is the day of institution of the Holy Communion. Good Friday is the day of Crucifixion and death of Jesus Christ on the Cross. On Easter Sunday we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

### Lent in Eastern Tradition (Calculation of Lent Days)

Different churches have taken different stands in calculating the 40 days' lent. In the Syrian tradition the custom of observing Lent for Seven Weeks – fifty days emerged. It was thus this Lent came to be known as fifty days lent – Lent and the Great Lent. In the Anglican, C.S.I. and Latin Catholic Church with Western Liturgical tradition Lent was not observed on Sundays, as it is the day of Resurrection. So these churches calculated the forty days from Ash Wednesday to the day of Resurrection. In the western churches Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, with the service of marking sign of the Cross on the head with ash as a sign of repentance. In the Jacobite, Thoziyoor, Orthodox, Mar Thoma, Malankara Catholic Churches which follow Antiochene liturgical tradition, Lent was not observed on Saturday the day of hopeful waiting for Resurrection and also on Resurrection Sunday. But the fasting is seen in continue. Instead of these days the ten days from the 'Fortieth Friday' were fixed for meditation on Passion, Crucifixion and Resurrection. Thus, the observance of the Lent was prolonged to seven weeks of the seven days. Thus, the Great Lent is arranged for fifty days. –

### Biblical Basis for Lent

The Old and New Testaments refer to fasting and Lent which were indispensable elements in the religious life of the Israelites. The custom of fasting in repentance was usual in the life of Jews in times of Crises and repentance. Kings and prophets have convened people and exhorted them to fast as a sign of repentance and atone for sins – (Jonah 2:5-7). Prophets and people used to fast to attain God's blessings and also before they were to face God –(Exodus 34:28). Moses had fasted for 40 days for the meeting with God on Mount Sinai. In New Testament Jesus asks disciples to pray and fast- Matthew 9:14, Mark 2:18). Jesus is also strengthened through fasting and praying before he began his public ministry that led him to the ministry followed by passion, crucifixion and resurrection. It is the mysterious sharing in and identification with the suffering of the Lord that must become possible today through the observation of the Lent.
